under said Borough or Town where such Brothers of the Guild may
assemble themselves And that any one Guild or Brotherhood may and
can Yearly for ever Elect and constitute for itself one Warden or Governor being
One of the aforesaid Brotherhood who may Exercise the Office of Warden
for one whole year and not more And further of our more abundant special
Grace certain knowledge and mere Motion we give and by these presents
for us our Heirs and Successors Grant to the said Chief Magistrate Bailiffs

and by these presents for us our Heirs and Successors we Grant to the
said Mayor Bailiffs Free Burgesses and Community of said Town or
Borough of Wexford and their Successors That there may be one Guild of
Merchants Staple in and under said Town or Borough and the Franchises
thereof consisting of one Mayor Two Constables and of such a Number of
Merchants of the said Town or Borough as to the said Mayor and
Constables of the Guild of Merchants Staple aforesaid for the time being
shall be seen better. And therefore we are willing and by this our
present Charter for us our Heirs and Successors we make constitute

Letters Patents untill the Feast of Saint Michael the Archangel to
happen next. And we also by these presents make constitute and
ordain Richard Stafford and Stephen Godd Constables of said Guild
of Merchants Staple of said Town or Borough from the said time untill
the Feast of Saint Michael the Archangel aforesaid and that for ever
after the said Feast of Saint Michael the Archangel next to be the
Mayor and Constables of said Guild of Merchants Staple of said
Town or Borough may be Annual and that from thence the Mayor of
the said Town or Borough for the preceding year may be for ever be Mayor
of said Guild of Merchants Staple for one year then next following and
no more And that the Bailiffs of the said Town or Borough for the
preceding year be for ever Constables of said Guild of Merchants Staple
of the Town or Borough of Wexford aforesaid for one year then next
following and no more and that the Mayor and Constables of said
Guild of Merchants Staple for the time being for ever may have full and
absolute Power and authority of receiving and Certifying thereupon all
and singular Statutes or Recognizances Staple taken or to be taken in or
under the Town or Borough aforesaid and the Franchises and Liberties

by these presents for us our Heirs and Successors to the said Chief
Magistrate Bailiff Free Burgesses and Community of the said Town
or Borough and their Successors for ever to the only and proper use and
Need of the said Chief Magistrate Bailiffs Free Burgesses and Community
of said Town or Borough of Wexford and their Successors for ever all
and singular Castles Messuages Tosts Backsides Gardens Wastes
Foundations Lands Tenements Meadows Pastures Common

Related We give and grant by these presents for us our Heirs and
Successors to the said Chief Magistrate free Burgeses and Community
of the said Town or Borough and their Successors for ever That all
Boats Ships and Wherries coming in or to the said County of Wexford
shall henceforth Discharge and unlade at the Town or Borough
of Wexford aforesaid and not elsewhere saving always and
reserving to the Superior Provost and Burgeses of the Town of New
Ross otherwise Rosport and their Successors their ancient Liberties,
Franchises and privileges And that it may be Lawful to the said

other Fair to be held yearly for ever upon the Feast of All Saints and for two
other days immediately following so as none of the said days shall happen
to be Sunday in which Case we are willing and Grant that every Fair so
respectively happening shall begin and be held on the Monday then
