Labourers' (Ireland) Act, 1886 (Sec 161)

To

The Local Government Board for Ireland.

The Petition of the Board of Guardians of New Ross Union, acting as the Rural Sanitary Authority for the Rural Sanitary District of the said Union.

Sheweth.

1. That by the New Ross Union Labourers' Order 1888, bearing date the 22nd day of June, 1888, and which became absolute on the 19th day of September, 1888. Your Petitioners were authorized to acquire compulsorily for a term of 99 years for the purposes of the Labourers' Acts, certain parcels or plots of land within the said District specifically mentioned in the Schedule to said order and therein numbered 9. 21. 38. 62. 81. 86. 90. 98. 164. — and 207. respectively.

2. That by reason of the representations made to them by the respective Occupiers of the lands upon which said several plots of land are situate. Your Petitioners permitted the said plots to be exchanged for others situate on the same lands respectively, without having previously obtained the sanction of Your Honourable Board for such exchanges; and Your Petitioners erected, or are in course of erecting, or have entered into Contracts for the erection of Labourers' Dwellings on the sites so substituted. —

3. That by virtue of the said order Your Petitioners were also empowered to acquire as aforesaid, a plot of land forming part of the holding of one Edward Bassett,

situate in the Townland of Fethard in said District and numbered 56 in said Schedule, and on the deposited Maps referred to in said Order; but the Labourer's Dwelling - intended to be erected on the said plot was by mistake erected on a plot of land situate in the adjoining townland of Ralph in said District and in the occupation of one James Murphy.

4. That by virtue of the said Order Your Petitioners were also empowered to acquire, as aforesaid, a plot of land situate at Knockea in said District in the occupation of one John Connor and numbered 92 in said Schedule; but the site of said plot was omitted to be marked on the said Maps, whereas, a site intended to represent same was marked and numbered 92 on said Maps on the lands of an adjoining occupier named Patrick O'Neill; and Your Petitioners - without having the site of the said plot authorized to be taken as aforesaid, correctly marked on said Maps, have taken possession of a plot forming part of the said lands of Knockea, in the occupation of the said John Connor, and have entered into a Contract for the erection of a Labourer's Dwelling thereon. -

5. That by virtue of the said Order Your Petitioners were also empowered to acquire, as aforesaid, a plot of land forming part of the holding of one Richard CODY situate at Ballycrony in said District and numbered 187 in said Schedule, but erroneously described as 188 on the said Maps; and Your Petitioners at the request of the said Richard CODY, and without the sanction of Your Honourable Board exchanged the said plot of land for another plot forming part of the said lands of - Ballycrony in the occupation of the said Richard CODY, and have erected a Labourer's Dwelling thereon. -

6. That Your Petitioners are informed and believe that the sites upon which said dwellings have been erected, or are being erected, or in respect of which - Contracts have been entered into, as aforesaid, and which

which are coloured blue and numbered on the Ordnance Maps accompanying this Petition with the numbers 95, 215, 385, 625, 815, 865, 905, 925, 985, 1645, 1875, and 2075 respectively, are in every way as suitable as the sites sanctioned by the said Order, and that the Engineering Inspector of Your Honourable Board has so reported, save in the case of number 215, to which Your Petitioners have been informed, his attention has not been drawn.

7 - That the substitution and amendments hereinafter prayed for are not objected to by any of the Owners, Lessees, or Occupiers of the lands affected thereby, as appears by the several Consents accompanying this Petition.

Your Petitioners therefore pray that Your Honourable Board may be pleased to make an Order sanctioning the several exchanges and amendments mentioned in this Petition.

Improvement Scheme No. 3.

In accordance with Public Notice and Special Notices to each Member of the Sanitary Authority the Guardians proceeded to make an Improvement Scheme.

W. J. R. Bolger the Guardians' Solicitor was in attendance, and submitted the several documents connected with the proposed Improvement Scheme. The following was adopted unanimously

Labourers' (Ireland) Acts 1883 to 1892.

Improvement Scheme (Third)

The Board of Guardians of New Ross Union acting as the Rural Sanitary Authority having received the accompanying representations from Ratepayers resident, and ~~agricultural~~ agricultural labourers employed within the Electoral Divisions of Adamstown, Ballyanne, Ballybeck, Brownford, Carnagh, Carrigbyrne, Clonleigh, Dunmain, Dysertmoon, Glynm, Inch, Kilgarvan, Killesk, Kilmokea, Kyle, Listerlin, Newbawn, Oldcourt, Oldross, Rathrol, Rochestown, Rosbercon, Shanbogh, Templetown, Templeudigan, The Rowes, Tinnahinch, Whitechurch and Whitemoor in pursuance of the above-mentioned Acts, and having duly considered such representations, and being satisfied of the truth thereof, and of the sufficiency of their resources, hereby make an Improvement Scheme in respect of the said Electoral Divisions as sections of the Sanitary District for the purpose of effectually remedying the state of things set forth in the said representations, -

1. The Sanitary Authority propose: -

(a) That with a view to provide increased house accommodation for agricultural labourers the Sanitary Authority shall acquire the lands set forth in the second column of the first schedule hereto and build on the respective lands the number of cottages specified in the third column of the said Schedule.

(b) That with a view to providing suitable dwellings for agricultural labourers in lieu of their present dwellings which have been certified to be

unfit for habitation, the Sanitary Authority shall acquire the lands set forth in the second column of the second Schedule here to, and build on the respective lands the number of cottages specified in the third column of the said Schedule. —

2. The Sanitary Authority propose to take — compulsorily by way of absolute purchase the lands described in the third Schedule here to.

3. All the lands proposed to be acquired are indicated on the accompanying Maps, and so far as the Sanitary Authority believe the proviso to Section 6 of the Labourers' (Ireland) Act, 1883, as amended by Section 3 of the Labourers' (Ireland) Act 1886 is duly observed.

4. The cottages to be created are intended to be built in accordance with the accompanying Plans, Specification and Estimate.

5. The total cost of the Scheme in regard to the acquisition of lands, cost of building cottages, and legal, engineering, and incidental expenses is estimated at £15,450. —

6. The area upon which the Sanitary Authority determine to charge the cost of the Scheme, so far as it relates to each Electoral Division, consists of such Electoral Division. —

7. The Sanitary Authority intend to carry the Scheme into execution themselves (subject however to the provisions of Section 12 of the Labourers' (Ireland) Act, 1883) and they propose to borrow the moneys required to defray

defray the cost of the scheme from the
Commissioners of Public Works.
