Extract from Mr O'Brien Smith's
report dated 24th March 1894

Of the 120 houses for which loans are sanctioned 108 were completed upon the occasion of my last inspection in November, 1893, and of the 7 houses the progress is only now completed and tenanted, and 4 are still unfinished. One other house 21 Electoral Division Carrons town has been contracted for, and the ~~remaining~~ ^{remaining} 4 houses are abandoned.

In the case of two of the houses unfinished to 191 Electoral Division of Shanbogh and 508 Electoral Division of Kilmore a possession has been taken by the applicants, the kitchen floors not been laid or doors hung and in the case of 108 the sashes or doors provided, and although in the latter case the Guardians special attention was directed to this house in my last report.

Nothing has been done since my last inspection. In the case of No. 56 Electoral Division of Grethard the house appears to be completed but is locked up and the windows boarded up - the offices are not floored nor are gates provided and the fence has fallen for one half the length of the plot. In the case of No 95 Electoral Division of Killesk the roof timbers are on but some of the rafters are defective and should be replaced with sound ones. The Guardians appear to be utterly too lenient with the Contractors, and no effort has been made to have the works completed. In the cases of the houses No. 191 and 56. the works have been in hands for over five years and are still incomplete, this is very reprehensible and measures should be taken to have these houses completed within a reasonable period, as until



He also reports that in the case of Site 146 on map 40 in Yintern Electoral Division, the land is of an inferior quality, and he suggests that the Guardians should specially consider whether it is advisable to take this plot as it seems to him to be hardly a place upon which public money ought to be expended. I am at the same time to enclose an extract from the report as to the selection of tenants for Cottages already provided by the Guardians under the Labourers Acts.

Extract from Mr Lynch-Staunton's report
Dated 5th July 1894

It would appear from the evidence (page 47) that the Guardians in arranging for the occupation of the cottages when built do not select as tenants in some instances, those persons who have put forward representations and given evidence at the inquiries, thus doing a grave injustice, and frustrating not infrequently the object of the Acts by accepting as tenants those who are in no sense bona fide agricultural Labourers.

I have reason to believe this course has been too often adopted, and it seems requisite to instruct the Guardians as to

their duty in this matter, so that for the future a more economical and juster course may be pursued.




