Dear Sir,

In reply to yours of the 5th instant, I beg to say that I did not consider it was part of my duty to mark the positions of the dwelling-houses and out-offices under the 3rd Improvement Scheme. I enclose copy of your letter which led me to believe that my duties were to mark sites on duplicate Ordnance sheets, survey and lock-split these sites and prepare four enlargements of same, all of which has been done long since. My contract price was seven shillings for each approved site, and two shillings and six pence for each rejected site. I certainly would not have included the marking of the positions for the cottages and out-offices at that rate, as I consider that would be the duty of the architect or Clerk of Works.

When I went around first marking the sites under this scheme I lock-split every site - a thing of which some guardians may be aware - so that I might facilitate matters when the fences would be erected, this is five years ago. I was able to see the best position of
