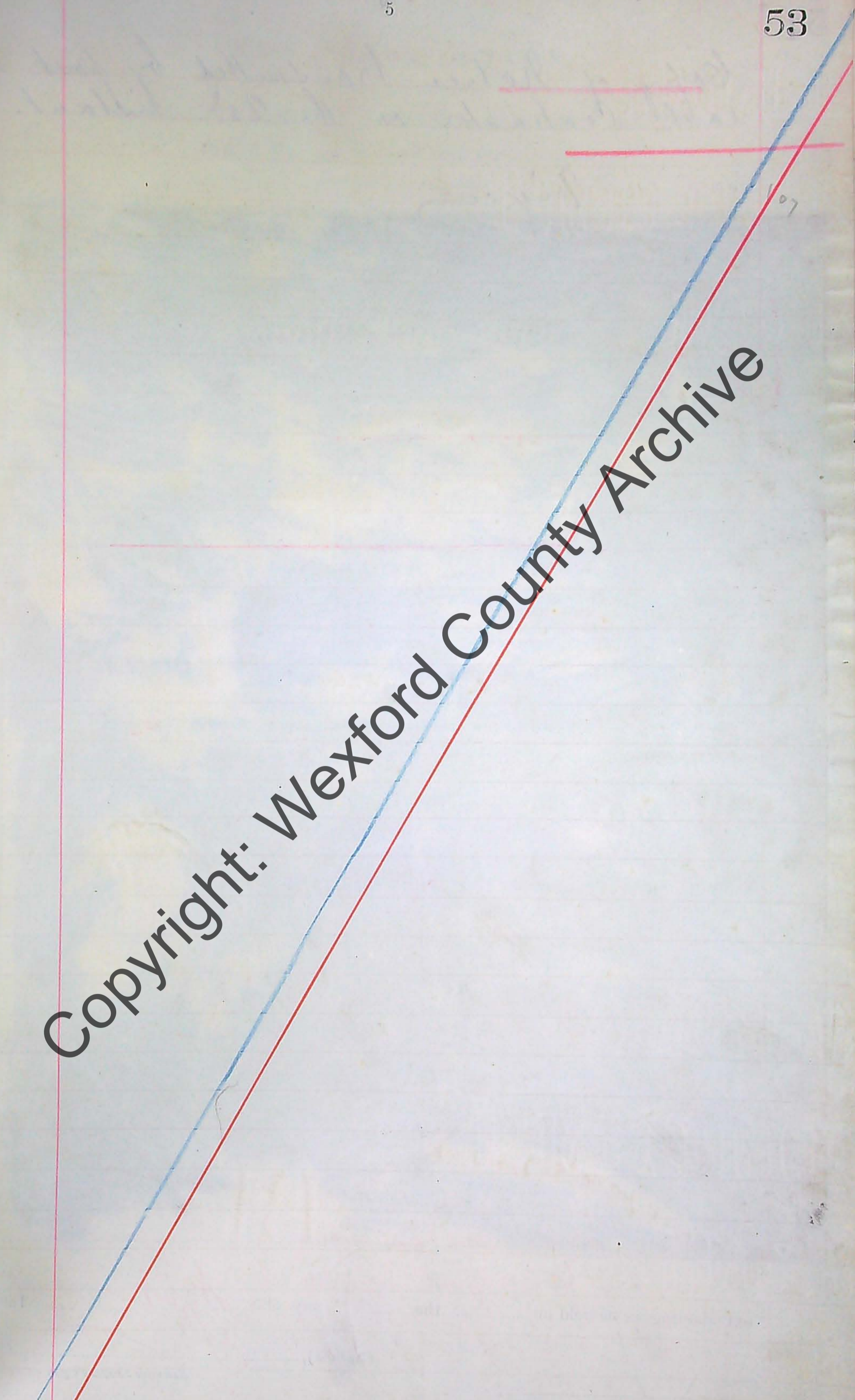



I am directed by the Local Government Board for Ireland to forward, to be laid before the Board of Guardians of New Ross Union, the accompanying extracts from the report of the Board's Engineering Inspector, Mr. O'Brien Smyth, on his recent inspection of the cottages erected in the Union in pursuance of the Improvement Scheme under the Labourers Acts authorised by Provisional order dated 28<sup>th</sup> March, 1895; and I am to request that the matters referred to by the Inspector may receive the attention of the Guardians.

With respect to the two cases in which the Inspector reports that the cottages have been built upon sites different from those authorised, I am to state that it will be necessary for the Guardians to forward the comments, in writing, of the persons interested in the lands and maps showing the plots actually taken with a view to an order being issued under Section 16 Act of 1898, sanctioning the alterations. Having regard to the number of houses completed and in progress, but excluding the two cottages referred to, the Local Government Board will recommend the Commissioners of Public Works to issue to the Guardians (on their making the necessary application therefor) the following further instalments of the Loans granted for the purposes of the Scheme,

Extract from Engineering Inspector's Report. dated 25<sup>th</sup> November 1898. 151

Of the 44 houses sanctioned seven are completed but not as yet tenanted, 19 are in course of construction, and the remaining 18 are not commenced. The works are being fairly executed in accordance with the plans, and under the Superintendence of Mr. Jones who accompanied me upon my inspection. In the following cases the sites have been changed from those indicated on the maps:— Electoral Division Ballyhaek, Townland Rosetown No 5 on Ordnance Sheet 44. Electoral Division Kilmokea, Townland Fisherstown No 67 on Ordnance Sheet 39.

It will be necessary to have these changes legalised under Section 16 of the Act of 1886, and with this view the consents of the owners and occupiers should be obtained and forwarded to the Board. The Guardians, contrary to custom have not fenced in the plots of land acquired, except in one case; this course renders the building works liable to injury from cattle trespassing on the lands and deprives the labourer of the benefit of the year's crop off the plot pending the completion of the cottages.

In reply to yours of 2nd instant, we fear we do not quite fully understand the position of this matter. It is said in Nolans letter to the Local Government Board that the site was wrongly marked out by Mr. Casey. Is this really so, and how was the site wrongly marked? Is it wrongly marked on the Ordnance map or wrongly pegged out on the land?

Again Mr Nolan asserts that the Guardians agreed to leave the question to be decided by Mr Dooley and the Superintendent of works. If this is so we think the Guardians would be bound by the decision of these

Gentlemen. But assuming that this is not the fact then in our opinion the question of liability depends upon whether the change or enlargement which took place caused increased difficulties in the way of the contractor. We gather from Mr. Jones report that if the enlargement had been made at first, the excavations could have been avoided, but this points to the conclusion that the contractor knew or should have known in the beginning, that the excavation would be necessary. On the whole therefore, unless the Guardians agreed to leave the decision to Mr. Dooley and Mr. Jones we consider there is no liability. We return Nolan's letter. — Yours truly
